Checkpoints Consumer Unit (CU)		
1. Is the Case Fill Rate on Consumer Unit (CU) higher than average for the product group it belongs to? See table for Case Fill Rate at www.tradesolution.no		
2. Is the Consumer Unit (CU) designed so that it does not break when handled and opened by the consumer?		
3. Is the packaging material in the Consumer Unit (CU) and the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) made to minimize environmental impact?		
4. Is the packaging for Consumer Unit (CU) and Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) designed to be recyclable? Check recyclability here: https://kalkulator.grontpunkt.no		
5. Can the packaging for Consumer Unit (CU) and Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) easily be recycled? Check the guideline here: https://www.grontpunkt.no/design-for-kildesortering		
6. Is the number of Consumer Units (CU) in the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) customized with regard to food waste and sales also for small shops?		
7. If 2D barcodes with dynamic information is used, has bilateral agreement been established?

8. Is the short side of the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) the exposure side?		
9. Is the product labelled according to the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) labelling requirements?		
10. Are the bar code labelling requirements of Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) with variable measure fulfilled?		
11. Is the product labelled with Grønt Punkt Norge (Green Point Norway) and relevant pictograms? Check packaging labeling here: https://www.grontpunkt.no/medlemskap/emballasjemerking/		
12. Can the combination of Consumer Unit (CU) and Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) be stacked and transported without damage to packaging and products?		
13. Is the weight of the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) a maximum of 15 kg?		
14. Is the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) easy to open and with instructions showing the opening method?		
15. Can the packaging be opened without using a knife?		
16. Is the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) designed to give the Consumer Unit (CU) a good exposure in the shop shelf / counter?		
17. If only foil is used as Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) packaging, are troughs / trays used under the products?		
18. After the foil has been removed, is the tray with products stable when it is lifted up and inserted into the shelf?		
Checkpoints Distribution Unit (DU)		
19. Is there the same number of Stock Keeping Units (SKU) on each layer of the Distribution Unit (DU)?		
20. Is Distribution Unit (DU) gross weight less than 1000 kg?		
21. Is the product designed according to the module system?		
22. Does the Distribution Unit (DU) keep a stable form during transport and storage in a way that damage does not occur on the packaging?		
23. Is one of the pallets approved by the Norwegian grocery sectors used?
