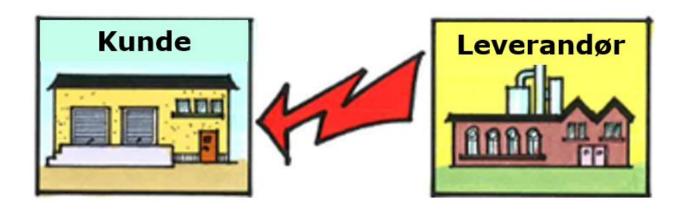

New CAN segment with code Z10 which specifies the number of pallet places the shipment occupies in transport

CPS

Packaging number

Missing SHALL / CAN code. Is entered as SHALL data segment hierarchy

Changed to a SHALL data element. Error in current user manual Level in packaging hierarchy

Removed. Not in use

PAC

Changed to a SHALL segment, since Despatch Advice is now only accepted at levels 3 and 4 and must be marked

Table of packing codes

New codes entered. Added column in table that shows which packet types are approved for use in Despatch Advice

Number of packages

Specified that the number now must be in relation to pallets Package Information Code

Removed codes 50 and 51, since this data item is now related to pallets.

MEA

Meaning that with measurement, it is meant the measurement of the pallet

Additional Information

Added new codes to replace the old ones.

PCI

Changed to a SHALL segment due to the fact that Despatch Advice is now only accepted at levels 3 and 4 and that PCI should therefore always be sent

Labelling instructions

Code 17 removed as it only applies to packet level 2, which is no longer allowed

New code 30 (SSCC) is added. Replaces 30E which is no longer a valid code.

Shipment labelling

Removed due to code 17 (above) deleted

GIN

Changed to a SHALL segment as a result of SSCC always being sent. Number from to
